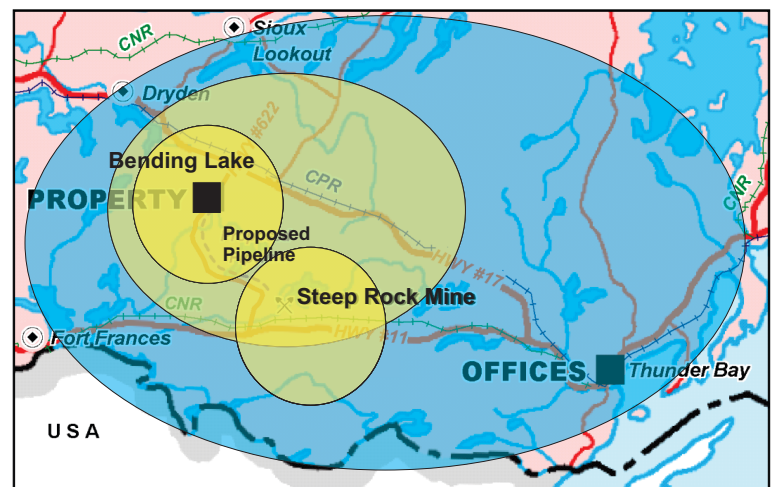
Mining can be a physically demanding industry however the pay is very good and there are plenty of opportunities for those wanting to make their mark.

The provincial government has given the green light to Bending Lake Iron Group to begin the environmental approval process that will lead to breathing new life into the former Steep Rock Mine site near Atikokan, Ontario. The company proposes to mine and transport ore from a planned mine at Bending Lake to the nearby pig iron processing facility. Henry Wetelainen, President and CEO of Bending Lake Iron Group Limited says approval will lessen the financial risks and help the community raise \$900 million to build out the project to create 700 construction jobs and 300 long-term jobs.

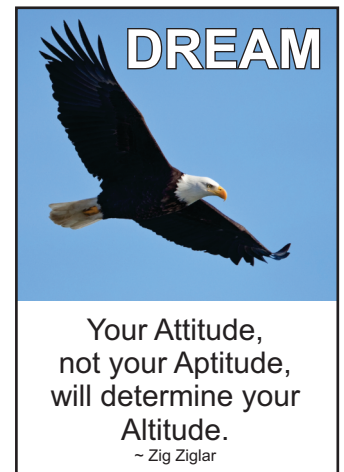
